Preparation

- *Identify church members who will pray daily for the families represented by the roses.*
- *Select a special place in your church for the focal point of the Elizabeth Ministry Rosebud Program's "Blessing Bouquet." You will need a table big enough to hold a basket, a vase, direction display and the prayer card holders.*
- *Roses need to have the tags attached with ribbon before they are put in the basket.*
- *Place direction display next to the basket.*
- *Make the prayer cards available by displaying them next to the vase in the prayer cards holder.*

Follow-up

Check the names on the rosebuds in the vase weekly. If you have a Chapter of Elizabeth Ministry, assign Elizabeth Ministers to visit each family represented by a rosebud. Each church decides how long the roses remain in the vase. When the rosebuds are removed from the vase they may be given to the family or add new tags and place them in the basket to re-circulate them.

Elizabeth Ministry Rosebud Program

*The Rosebud Program
"Blessing Bouquet"
honors the sacredness of life.*

Silk rosebuds are placed in a basket and set next to a vase with silk baby's breath flowers. These realistic silk rosebuds each represent a sacred life. A pink rosebud is to honor pregnancy and the unborn baby. A red rosebud celebrates a birth or adoption. A yellow rosebud represents prayers requested for those desiring to conceive, suffering infertility or seeking to adopt, A white rosebud remembers a child lost through miscarriage, abortion, stillbirth, infant or child death.

Each rosebud has a tag attached with a ribbon. The tag has a place to write information regarding pregnancy, birth, adoption, loss, or waiting to conceive or adopt. People are invited to remove a rosebud from the basket, fill in the attached tag and put the rose in the vase.

Prayer cards for the various situations are displayed next to the vase. Those filling out the tags are invited to take a prayer card for their personal meditation. Church members promise to pray for those the rosebuds represent.

Elizabeth Ministry offers hope and healing to women and their families on issues related to childbearing, sexuality and relationships.
